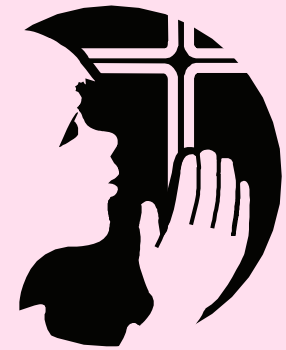
Bishop Daniel Thiagarajah's Message
